Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free from internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Arizona law requires rabies vaccine every 3 years.

RING INFORMATION:

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. This trial will be held in 3 rings. The Standard and JWW rings will be 100 feet by 100 feet in diameter and the FAST ring will be 80 feet wide by 90 feet long. All rings will run simultaneously. Exhibitors should be prepared to have walked more than one course. Exhibitors with potential conflicts must inform the gate steward BEFORE the class starts. Except in EXTRAORDINARY circumstances, there will be no additional walk-throughs. A conflict is viewed as when either the handler has to be in another ring/event with the same or a different one of "their" dogs or the dog has to be in another ring/event. It is the gate steward's discretion where the dog will be placed in the running order. Wanting to see someone else run another one of your dogs in a different event does not constitute a conflict. The club hosting the trial and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service, runners or public address systems for the purpose of locating or calling dogs that are not brought to the ringside when required. This trial will be held outside on grass, regardless of weather. There is NO shade available but lots of room to set up.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

The AKC Canine Partners program is for mixed breed dogs AND DOGS INELIGIBLE FOR AKC REGISTRATION. For more information see <http://www.akc.org/mixedbreeds/index.cfm>.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

PRIZES AND AWARDS:

First through Fourth place rosettes will be awarded in each class for each height division for qualifying scores. Qualifying ribbons will also be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. Double Q ribbons, beautiful MACH poles and MACH ribbons will also be awarded to those who earn them.

We will also be awarding rosettes for new titles.

All awards must be collected during the show. None will be held over or mailed. Awards will not be available until judges have reviewed the appropriate scribe sheets. We will be using NCR sheets.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS:

Regular Classes

8 Inches	For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers
12 Inches	For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
16 Inches	For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
20 Inches	For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
24 Inches	For dogs over 22 inches at the withers
26 Inches	Dogs may be entered at this height at their owner's discretion

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Exhibitors are responsible for verifying the proper jump height is set prior to running. Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. If the dog's height at the withers exceeds the maximum allowed for the jump height which the dog has entered, the dog shall be moved-up into the proper jump height if the dog was measured prior to their run. In no case may a dog be moved down in height based on a judge's measurement at a trial. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs they believe might belong in a different division, and any dog whose entry in a given division might be questioned. In the Preferred Classes handlers must jump the height called for and may not jump higher.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION:

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION:

The trial will be conducted under American Kennel Club **Regulations for Agility Trials**. For copies of the Regulations, write to The American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Dr #100, Raleigh NC 27617-3390 or call (919) 854-0199. Regulations can also be printed directly from the Internet - <http://www.akc.org/agregs.htm>.

Entries must reach the Trial Secretary by 6 PM MST, January 5, 2011. Fees must accompany entries. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. Entry fees are non-refundable except for bitches coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of total entry fee paid with a veterinarian's note. Checks will be deposited as soon as the show closes. A returned check will invalidate an entry and a \$25 service fee will be charged.

It is the responsibility of the owner or his/her agent to enter the appropriate class. The trial secretary will not automatically change entries to conform to AKC rules. Dogs may not move between regular and preferred classes once the trial has closed

Move ups to a higher class will occur from Friday to Saturday and from Saturday to Sunday. A move-up book will be at the show site on Friday at the ribbon table. The request must be made to the Trial Secretary no later than ½ hour after the last class each day. **ALL pre-show move-ups must be emailed to jdoepke@cox.net No pre-show move-ups after 6pm MST January 17, 2010.**

The judging will start at 9 am on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for the judging of their class. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. **Any exhibitor entering this trial acknowledges that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all of the obstacles safely.**

Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. There will be no refund of entry fee for exhibitors that are asked to leave the show site because of their dog or children creating unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engaging in unsafe behavior. The Superstition Kennel Club may decline any entry for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog because of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.

No glass containers are allowed on the property.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed due to riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

MOTELS:

Make Your Reservations Early, this is tourist season. Owners are responsible for any damage and cleaning up after their dogs. Dogs must not be left unattended in motel rooms. Non-compliance may result in a bench show hearing.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
